## Spelunker ("caver" def. Dictionary of Geological Terms).

Speleology (The exploration, description and scientific study of caves and related phenomena).

The Kansas City Star newspaper this year began formatting the Sunday and Wednesday publications as a feature issue. Recently (Wed., May 25, 2022) the topic, entitled "The Hole World", concerned caves in Missouri, of which there are documented more than 7,000 of interest. Most of the caves are on private property, however many that are accessible are managed/operated by the state Department of Natural Resources. In 2016 the MO Caves Association indicated that over 750,000 "cavers' passed through their gates, clearly indicating the popularity of the sites and caving as a hobby.
